#### **Pre-Survey Feedback from Accordian Primary School (sample size of 23 girls)**

- 74% of the girls come from single parent households
- 78% come from households where the parent is either unemployed or works sometimes
- 82% of the girls have no knowledge of why they get their period
- 52% use pads provided for by the school and 22% uses various methods for their period
- 82% miss school for reasons ranging from period pains and lack of resources
- 100% would appreciate the sanitary wear and would be glad to receive them.
